

CAIRNS (QUEENSLAND), AUSTRALIA

The fourth most popular destination for international tourists visiting Australia (after Sydney, Melbourne, and Brisbane) - Cairns is a gateway to the Great Barrier Reef. Founded in 1876, and named after Sir William Wellington Cairns following discovery of gold in the Hodgkinson River

PORT LOCATION

Ships dock at the Cairns Cruise Liner Terminal, which is about 6-minute drive or 20-minute walk from the CBD

Getting Around: The closer bus terminal to the port is Cairns City Bus Station. Tickets can be purchased onboard the bus in cash. A single (one-way) ticket allows 2 hours of travel (from \$2.40 for single zone), and a Daily Ticket allows unlimited travel (from \$4.80 for single zone).

For taxis, dial 131 008 (Cairns Taxis). There is a taxi call station just outside the terminal www.translink.com.au (click here for network map)

CAIRNS CBD HIGHLIGHTS

Rusty's Market: One of the most well-known markets in Australia and abroad. Three-day market with over 180 stalls. 5a-6p (Fri-Sat), 5a-3p (Sun) | Free | 4-minute drive/12-minute walk (1km from port) www.rustysmarkets.com.au

Reef Eye Ferris Wheel: Reach a height of about 35m (100ft), with great views over the water and city. Located at the Esplanade. 10a-10p | \$12 | 5-minute drive/12-minute walk (1km from port)

KURANDA HIGHLIGHTS

For over 10,000 years the Aboriginal Djabugay tribe has called the Kuranda area home, Known as the Village in the Rainforest, Kuranda is a major tourist attraction for visitors to the Cairns region. The best way to get to Kuranda from Cairns is to take the **Skyrail Rainforest Cableway** from Smithsfield (8:30a-4:45p, \$117 return), or to take the **Kuranda Scenic Railway**. Bus options include **Jon's Kuranda Bus**.

Butterfly Sanctuary: Home to over 1500 intricately decorated tropical butterflies, including the largest butterfly in all of Oz – the Cairns Birdwing. Largest butterfly aviary in the Southern Hemisphere. 9:30a-3:30p | \$22 | 38-minute drive (30 km from port)

REEFS & BEACHES

Cairns is probably most-popular for its proximity to the Great Barrier Reef and many day boats and liveaboard tours head out from Cairns to explore the world's largest reef

Green Island: Part of the Great Barrier Reef, Green Island is the only element of the coral reef to have a rainforest growing on it. Also home to a resort, with food and facilities. \$96 (inc. ferry) | 45-minute ferry www.green-island.com.au

Fitzroy Island: Famous for its beautiful beaches (of which there are three). Nudey Beach was once named Best Beach in Australia. Also popular for the Turtle Centre. \$90 (inc. ferry) | 45-minute ferry www.fitzroyisland.com

Barron Beach: Closest beach to Cairns, on other side of Cairns Airport. 19-minute drive (13km from port)

Palm Beach: North of Cairns at the edge of Kuranda National Park. 35-minute drive (30km from port)

Crystal Cascades: A peaceful, secluded freshwater swimming hole. 30-minute drive (21km from port)
