The southernmost city in Australia, Hobart is second oldest only to Sydney. Hobart has maintained its historic charm - more so than other cities, and is very walkable. Only 40% of Tasmanians live in the capital, making it the most decentralized state

Ships dock at Macquarie Wharf, which is a 20 minute walk to the CBD (1.3km)

BEST OF HOBART

Tasmanian Museum & Art Gallery: Established in 1846 by the Royal Society of Tasmania - the oldest Royal Society outside of England. See the 'Our Land: Parawa, Parawa! Go away!' exhibition about colonialism from an Aboriginal perspective

Maritime Museum of Tasmania: Private collection, including the oldest free-standing statue in Australia - a functionally plumbed, 1.3m colonial gentleman in the act of urination.

Hobart Convict Penitentiary: Four convict-themed experiences in one ticket. Visit the convict memorial, view a video presentation of Tasmania's convict years (Pandemonium) in the prison chapel, explore a photo gallery of convicts' portraits (Rogues' Gallery), and tour the site.

Eternal Flame Memorial: Hobart Cenotaph is the main military monument in the city and stands directly above the former Queens Battery site. In 2015, the Flame of Remembrance and Pool were unveiled.

Nutgrove Beach: In the suburb of Sandy Bay. Also nearby: Long Beach, Lords Beach, Red Chapel Beach.

JUST OUT OF TOWN

Kunanyi / Mount Wellington: The mountain towering over Hobart is 200m taller than Cape Town's famous Table Mountain. Reaching 1271m, there's an observation site at the top and lots of trails.

Mt Pleasant Radio Telescope Observatory: Operated by the University of Tasmania in Cambridge, this three-telescope site is the birthplace of radio astronomy, pioneered by Grote Reber, who has a museum onsite named after him.

Cascade Brewery: The oldest operating brewery in Australia, established in 1824 by a convict (at the time still incarcerated). Tours and an onsite bar make this a popular attraction.

Cascades Female Factory: World Heritage-listed factory and former prison, telling the story of displacement, mistreatment and forced migration of convict women and girls.

Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary: Meaning 'native companion', this wildlife sanctuary (30km from Hobart/30-minute drive) runs a Tasmanian Devil breeding program. Also chance to meet Tasmanian Tree Frogs, Pademelons, Bettongs, Possums, Emus and many more of Australia's fauna.
