PORT LOCATION

Cabo San Lucas is a tender port, so guests ferry to the dock by tender boats. The tender ride is about 0.9 nautical miles and takes around 10-minutes. The tender pier is at the south of the marina.

Getting Around: The best way around Cabo San Lucas is on foot or by car. Sites are clustered within the downtown area, though a scenic water taxi can get you from the downtown marina to the best beaches. The public bus costs around \$2.50 one-way and most buses stop wherever you want to be dropped off - just tell the driver when you board.

Taxis: Taxis are expensive and can be as much as \$30 one-way out along the Tourist Corridor (roughly \$7/mile).

Wejulia Beach: closest beach to the tender pier. Waves can be quite powerful here. 7-minute walk (?)

Playa de los Amantes: secluded golden beach set between dramatic limestone rock formations. 11-minute walk (?)

El Medano Beach: most popular and main safe-swimming beach in town, to the north of the marina. 30-minute walk (?)

Chileno Beach: swimming and snorkeling beach, located along the tourist corridor of Cabo San Lucas. 15-minute drive

Santa Maria Beach: one of the most beautiful beaches in Los Cabos. 15-minute drive

Cabo Cantina Sports Bar Restaurant: favorite in Cabo San Lucas serving breakfast, lunch and dinner with live sports on HD widescreens, live music. 5-minute walk

Iglesia de San Lucas and Town Square: located a short jaunt from the marina. The landmark is the main church in Cabo San Lucas and an excellent place to view local architecture as well as observe local traditions.

Cultural Pavilion of the Republic: Cultural center with performance and exhibition spaces. 8a-11p | 🚱 | 🖰

Cabo San Lucas Whale Watching: whale watching is extremely popular in Cabo, with many visitors saying it's an absolute must-do activity. Generally, the best time to spot whales is between December through April, with January through March offering the chance to see baby whales, too.
